- 1) Applicants should have at least one year of research or teaching experience after obtaining a Ph.D. or equivalent degree. (At the time of application)
- 2) Applicants must be legally eligible to work at a private university in Korea.
- 3) Applicants must agree with the general Christian education principles espoused by Yonsei University.
- 4) A certain number of credit hours must be taught in English. (Except HK faculties)

3. Required Documents

- A. Two copies of completed application form and one copy of statement of religious affiliations
- B. Each copy of diplomas and transcripts (Including the Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree, Ph.D.)
* May submit photocopies; however, applicants selected for open lecture/interview must submit the original copy of the documents at the time of open lecture/interview.
- C. Two printed copies of the list & the summary of research publication(s) (or equivalent documentation for exhibitions)

* For the main achievements (up to three may be selected), check "main achievement" on the list of research records

6. Evaluation Criteria and Process

Stage 1) Suitability for the field of study/research

: whether the applicant's field of study/research matches the recruiting position in the department or program

Stage 2) Academic records and overall achievements

: a comprehensive evaluation of the applicant's academic excellence, teaching or research abilities, publication records according to the Faculty Achievement Evaluation criteria as outlined by each program or department

Stage 3) Open lecture/interview

: Based on the evaluation of 1) and 2), outstanding applicants will be invited for an open lecture and interview to evaluate his or her presentation content and skills, academic potentials, contributions to the university, as well as qualification as a faculty at Yonsei

7. Notification

1) The applicants who are invited for an open lecture and interview will be personally informed by the College/Department

2) Final decisions will be personally notified to the final candidates by e-mail.

8. Things to Check Before Submitting Your Application:

1) Incomplete applications will not be considered or accepted; once submitted, the applications will not be returned.

2) Applicants are personally responsible for any false, deficient or incomplete documents.

3) Please make sure to state all facts in your application materials accurately; Yonsei University has the right to revoke faculty appointments resulting from deficient information or false documents.

4) Applicants who are selected for an open lecture/interview must submit the official documents for diplomas and transcripts at the time of open lecture/interview.
